Verse 2 - Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds,

JOY MEANS "CONFIDENCE IN GOD"

Therefore, "Consider it "Confidence in God", whenever you face trials of many kinds"

We are commanded by God to "Count it all Joy" - - to have "confidence in God" in the midst of trials. If the sufferer is so broken over the trial or tragedy that they don't have this "joy", pray for them to have this "confidence in God"

Because it is commanded, it is within the ability and will of every true Christian to perform

How?

Only through the power of the Holy Spirit

The reason we can count it all iov because trials draw us closer to the Lord - the source of all JOY

Trials should draw us to:

- Studying the Word
- Prayer
- Attending Servides
- Christian fellowship

All of which will increase our JOY !!!

Also we know:

- 1. Our gracious heavenly Father uses trials not to harm us but to strengthen and perfect us
- 2. So, the only way out of a trial - - - is through it

5 key points on suffering

God did not create evil. suffering and death

Even though suffering is never good. God can and does use it to accomplish good

We decide whether suffering in this life will harden or soften

"When God saw all that He had made, and behold, it was all very good" ~ (Genesis 1:31)

Free of suffering and evil !!

He made man - -- and gave men free will.

Real love must involve real choice.....

The source of evil is not God's power but mankind's freedom!

You can't have a world where there's real choice. while at the same time no possibility for man to choose evil.

Consider Jesus - If it was the will of God that people suffer - than Jesus went against the will of God by healing them -- and Jesus never went against the will of God!

"The very triumphs of His foes he used for their defeat. He compelled their dark achievements to sub serve His ends, not theirs. They nailed Him to a tree, not knowing that by that very act they were bringing the world to His feet. They gave Him a cross, not quessing that He would make it a throne." James Stewart

I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us (Rom 8:18)

For our light and momentary troubles are achieving for us an eternal glory that far outweighs them all (II Cor 4:17)

Last - In His good time He can bring me out again - how and when He knows.

And we know that God causes all things (SUFFERING) to work together for good to those who love God (CHRISTIANS) , to those who are called according to His purpose. For whom he foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son (DEFINING GOOD = CHRISTLIKE), that He might be the first-born among many bretheren.






#### Solomon Asks for Wisdom


- 1 Solomon made an alliance with Pharaoh king of Egypt and married his daughter. He brought her to the City of David until he finished building his palace and the temple of the LORD, and the wall around Jerusalem. 2 The people, however, were still sacrificing at the high places, because a temple had not yet been built for the Name of the LORD. 3 Solomon showed his love for the LORD by walking according to the statutes of his father David, except that he offered sacrifices and burned incense on the high places.
- 4 The king went to Gibeon to offer sacrifices, for that was the most important high place, and Solomon offered a thousand burnt offerings on that altar. 5 At Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon during the night in a dream, and God said, "Ask for whatever you want me to give you."
- 6 Solomon answered, "You have shown great kindness to your servant, my father David, because he was faithful to you and righteous and upright in heart. You have continued this great kindness to him and have given him a son to sit on his throne this very day.
- 7 "Now, O LORD my God, you have made your servant king in place of my father David. But I am only a little child and do not know how to carry out my duties. 8 Your servant is here among the people you have chosen, a great people, too numerous to count or number. 9 So give your servant a discerning heart to govern your people and to distinguish between right and wrong. For who is able to govern this great people of yours?"
- 10 The Lord was pleased that Solomon had asked for this. 11 So God said to him, "Since you have asked for this and not for long life or wealth for yourself, nor have asked for the death of your enemies but for discernment in administering justice, 12 I will do what you have asked. I will give you a wise and discerning heart, so that there will never have been anyone like you, nor will there ever be. 13 Moreover, I will give you what you have not asked for both riches and honor-so that in your lifetime you will have no equal among kings. 14 And if you walk in my ways and obey my statutes and commands as David your father did. I will give you a long life." 15 Then Solomon awoke-and he realized it had been a dream.








# James 1:16-17

#### John 3

Nicodemus, like most teachers of Mosaic Law, taught that to please God you had to obey the law, and this of yourself.

"3In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again."

4"How can a man be born when he is old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely he cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb to be born!"

5Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. 6Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. 7You should not be surprised at my saying, "You must be born again." 8The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."

9"How can this be?" Nicodemus asked. "

Jesus explained the Spirit of God sovereignly moves where He will and gives new birth to whom He has predestined to salvation

The conclusion - the new birth is of God, not of man .....

This is the chief "good and perfect gift" that God gives to us

#### Matthew 7:7-11

## Ask, Seek, Knock

7"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. 8For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened.

9"Which of you, if his son asks for bread, will give him a stone? 10Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a snake? 11If you, then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give good gifts to those who ask him!

Consider God's goodness - - He gives His Spirit to address our biggest need and problem - - SIN!

Answer to our inward trials v 16 - 17

V13 + - Inward Trials

If the problem is in our heart - - then we need a new one!

God is not responsible for our temptations but is responsible for "every good and perfect gift given to us" - v17

V17 - Consider God's goodness:

- Every good and perfect gift is from above
- God gives these gifts
   to help you overcome
   trials (Luke 11:13)
- God is always willing and available to help with trials

V18 - He gives us (as verse 18 says "in the exercise of His will") a NEW BIRTH that leads to a NEW LIFE - new heart, new desires for God by the "Word of Truth"

Source of our inward trials v 13 - 15

Leads to a Strengthened Faith

#### Matthew 13:18-23

When trouble or persecution comes because of the word, he quickly falls away. 22The one who received the seed that fell among the thorns is the man who hears the word, but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke it, making it unfruitful. 23But the one who received the seed that fell on good soil is the man who hears the word and understands it. He produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown."

# D. L. Moody



"That will cost money," replied Bramwell. "Well, that is your affair. Something must be done. Get hold of a warehouse and warm it, and find something to cover them. But mind, Bramwell, no coddling!"
